2026 Art Gallery Call for Art

ENTRY DEADLINE: FRIDAY, OCTOBER 17, 2025

The Art Committee of York Hospital seeks proposals for artwork to be displayed in the hospital Café at York Hospital and featured virtually online in 2026. Each exhibition will be on view for three or four months (beginning in January 2026). Installations typically include 15 to 25 works of art, depending on the size of the pieces and the gallery's current hanging system.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES: Interested artists should submit, via email, a digital portfolio consisting of 4 to 6 representative pieces (JPGs, each approximately 1-2 MB in size), or a link to the artist's website or online gallery, for jury consideration. A biography or combined biography/artist's statement (ranging from a short paragraph to a maximum length of 500 words) should also be submitted. Please email all entry materials to the York Hospital Philanthropy Office at philanthropy@yorkhospital.com. **SUBMISSIONS MUST BE RECEIVED BY FRIDAY, OCTOBER 17, 2025, FOR CONSIDERATION.***

SELECTION PROCESS: The York Hospital Art Committee will review submissions and notify artists of their decision in November. The Art Committee strives to select inspirational, positive imagery in various two-dimensional media (oil or acrylic, watercolor, photography, silkscreen prints, etc.) and styles (i.e., still life, land- or seascapes, portraits, realistic or abstract art).

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS: Exhibiting artists must provide digital images of all artwork to be displayed (JPGs of approximately 1080 x 720 pixels at 72 dpi) and a corresponding checklist (with prices if pieces are for sale) **AT LEAST TWO WEEKS PRIOR TO THE EXHIBITION START DATE.** A portion of the proceeds from each art sale will support York Hospital programs.
